## Junior Player Permit for AGCC and ISEC Competitions

### Late developing player Permit

This permit is to gain permission for a late developing player to play in ISEC or AGCC. This permit provides provision for later developers or first year players having exceeded the age of eligibility of their age group by less than six months in accordance with ISEC and AGCC rules. Evidence of all playing experience, if any, shall be submitted with the permit.

### Female junior player Permit

This permit is also applicable for a female player seeking permission to play in the ISEC competition. This permit provides provision for a junior female cricketer to play in ISEC over their age group by up to a period of two years (in line with Cricket Australia policy).

### Process:

The permit below must be completed in full and submitted to the respective competition email addresses as listed above. A player CANNOT play in the desired competition until this permit has been approved. Approval will also need to be made by a Competition Administrator on the PlayHQ platform for the player to be selected in a team. This permit can be revoked at any time by the Competition Management Group (CMG). A competition official will respond with the acceptance or rejection of the permit within 3 days of submission.
