**GUIDELINES FOR CRICKET SOUTHERN BAYSIDE**

**PLAYING APPAREL**

# Overview

To ensure uniformity across the competition, Cricket Southern Bayside has developed these guidelines for all clubs to follow with regards to their white/cream and coloured uniforms across all grades.

## Logos

The Cricket Southern Bayside & Club logos will be optional additions to all playing uniforms in seasons 2016/17 & 2017/18. It will become a compulsory inclusion on all uniforms from season 2018/19.

Clubs will have the ability to have no more than three (3) sponsor's logos on their white/cream & coloured playing shirts. The positioning and size of these logos must conform to the rules outlined in these guidelines.

Clubs will also have the ability to display their club logo no more than one (1) sponsors logo on their white/cream & coloured playing pants. The positioning and size of these logos must conform to the rules outlined in these guidelines.

## Coloured Playing Apparel

It will be a requirement for players to wear coloured shirts in one-day and T20 matches in all grades during seasons 2016/17 and 2017/18. It will also be a requirement for all batsman and wicketkeepers to wear coloured pads (or CLADS) in all One-Day and T20 matches.

These requirements will have a transitional phase over two seasons with the requirement for full coloured uniforms for One-Day & T20 matches in effect in season 2018/19.

All uniform designs and requests to use the competition logo must be approved by the Working Party or Competition Management (once appointed).

# White/Cream Playing Shirts

## Right arm sleeve to remain property of Cricket Southern Bayside

This sleeve must remain clear (unless part of a sublimated pattern design) & wholly reserved for Cricket Southern Bayside to promote a sponsor at its discretion

*Optional: 2016/17 & 2017/18*  
*Requirement: 2018/19 onwards*

**Sponsor # 2**  
May be displayed on left arm sleeve  
not exceeding 64cm<sup>2</sup>

**Local Government logo**  
Clubs may also display their local government logo as a club/community partnership on the bottom half of left arm sleeve not exceeding 45cm<sup>2</sup>

*Optional: 2016/17 onwards*

**Sponsor # 1**  
May be displayed across midriff – not exceeding 10cm in height & 20cm in width

# White/Cream Playing Shirts

**Name** must measure between 6cm & 7.5cm only in height Name must be positioned above player number

Name to be family name only (no other name or nickname)

Apparel manufacturer's name/brand/ logo can only be centred between base of collar & top of player name & must not measure more than 3cm<sup>2</sup> in size

*Optional: 2016/17 onwards*

**Number** must measure between 25cm & 35cm only in height. Numbers are to be one or two digits only.

# Coloured Playing Shirts

**Name** must measure between 6cm & 7.5cm only in height Name must be positioned above player number

Displayed on upper left thigh/hip not exceeding 45cm<sup>2</sup>  
*Optional 2016/17 onwards*



## Sponsors logo

Displayed on upper left thigh/hip not exceeding 45cm<sup>2</sup>  
*Optional 2016/17 onwards*

can be displayed on upper left hamstring not exceeding 45cm<sup>2</sup>
